"Ranchos of S. Francisco district including all from Sta Clara Co. northward....Milpitas (Sta Clara, 1 L., 1835, José M. Alviso, who was cl. (Claim of Nicolas Berreyesa on a grant of 1834 rejected). [BC iii 712] "Berreyesa (Nicolas)...grantee of Milpitas '34, iii 712...
