"Inigo (Lope)...grantee of Posolmi and Pozito, Sta Clara '44. iv 672." [BC iv 690].
 "Ranchos of norther Cal., granted in 1841-5....Posolmi and Pozito de las Animas, 3,042 acres, 1844 Lope Inigo, R. Walkinshaw, cl." [BC iv 672]. "Walkinshaw (Robert)cl. for Santa Clara lands '52. iv 673. [672]." [BC v 767]. From an early period this land, shown on old maps as Ynigo Reservation, has been occupied by Indians, and in 1844, a formal grant of it was made to their chief. Before the patent was issued the land had been sold and the homes of five white men had been established on the land. [H]
