"Buelna (Antonio)....grantee of.....S. Francisquito in '39. iii 678,713." [BC ii 735]  
 "Ranchos of S. Francisco district, including all from Sta Clara Co. northward....San Francisquito (Sta Clara), 1839, Antonio Buelna; M. Concepción V. de Rodríguez et al cl" [BC iii 713]. "Speciman cases. . .Rodríguez, S. Francisquito, Sta Clara,...conf. on a grant of '39, but<sup>s</sup>a portion overlapped by a later grant 1st surveyed was lost. 29 Cal. 104." [BC vi 557] Antonio Buelna occupied this land from 1837. He had been active in the revolt that put Alvarado in power. He died three years after receiving his grant and
