Faustino, like his brother, lost all his land under the manipulations of Amer. sharpers and died in poverty." [BC iii 755]. "Ranchos of S. Francisco district, including all from Sta Clara northward.....Juristac, 1 l., (Sta Clara), 1835, A & F German, who were cl. [BC iii 712]. [Apparently, the German brothers disposed of their rights in this rancho after the allowance of their claim, but before issuance of patent, as Bancroft indicates the claim was allowed.
