"Linares (Vicente)...grantee of rancho at S. Luis Obispo." [BC iv 714]. "List of private ranchos granted 1841-5.....Ranchos not named in S. Luis Ob.,....1,000 v. 1842, Vicente Linares, who was cl." [BC iv656]. [Records of this office do not show any reason for the discrepancy in names of original grantee as between the archive copies and BC. However, it is possible that it is an error on the part of Bancroft as this is the only mention made of Vicente Linares, whereas Victor was grantee of two other ranchos, Tinaquatic and Cañada de los Osos, and was a fairly prominent man in San Luis Obispo according to BC.
