"Branch (Francis Ziba)...in '39...got a grant of the Sta Manuela rancho near S. Luis Obispo. iii 679; iv 655." [BC ii 727].."Ranchos of Monterey district, 1831-40....Sta Manuela, 1837, Francis Branch, who was cl. (San Luis Obispo Co.)." [BC iii 679]

"When Mr. Branch moved to his rancho, which was located in the Arroyo Grande Valley, Misión San Luis Obispo about thirteen miles to the north was almost the only community in the entire region which was inhabited by white people" [Hoover]
