"Lopez (Francisco). . .grantee of Los Alamos '46 v.627." [BC iv 718]. "Ranchos of Los Angeles district 1841-5. . .Alamos y Agua Caliente, 1843, Pedro C. Carrillo, who was cl." [BC iv 634] [according to BC this claim was disallowed by the l.c.]. "Ranchos in Los Angeles district . . .Los Alamos y Agua Caliente, 6 l., granted in 1846 to Francisco Lopez et al; Agustin Olvera cl." [BC v 627]. [About the only explanation in regard to grantees and claimants that can be made here is that probably Carrillo received the original grant and then disposed of his interest to Lopez, Jordan, and Bottilier. Carrillo, in spite of the fact that he had disposed of his interest, possibly tried to obtain the rancho anyway, before the land commi
