* "Claim being founded on 3 Mex. grants, the 1st made Dec. 1st, 1842 by Juan B. Alvarado to Victor Linares for the tract of land called Canada de los Osos, the 2nd made Apr. ^(6 days) 27, 1843 by Manuel Micheltoarena--to Francisco Padillo for the tract called Pecho y Islay, and the third made Sept. 24, 1845 by Pio Pico---to Diego Scott and Juan Wilson for said two tracts to the extent of 7 1/2 sq. leagues, which last grant was approved by the Departmental Assembly Oct. 1, 1845."
