"Ranchos of San Francisco district, including all from Sta Clara Co. northward...Sta Teresa (Santa Clara), 1 L., 1834, Joaquin Bernal; Augustin Bernal, cl. [BC iii 713] "Augustin Bernal....'53 claimant of Sta Teresa rancho iii 713..."[BC ii 717] "The exact date of his [Bernal's] taking possession is not known. But in July 1834 when he (at the age of ninety-four) petitioned Governor Figueroa for the property, he had lived on the place for some years." [H] "Three hundred acres are now held by descendants of the original grantee." [H]
