

Módulo de instrucción #2: El trabajo

Segunda parte [Applying creatively]

Entrevista a un trabajador hispano: En este módulo, vas a realizar una entrevista de vídeo a un/a trabajador/a hispano/a sobre la experiencia de vivir y trabajar en los Estados Unidos.

1. Pasos a seguir:

1. Identifica una persona que puedas entrevistar. Puede ser un miembro de tu familia, un/a vecino/a, etc. El requisito es que trabaje aquí y sea un/a inmigrante.
2. Prepara una serie de preguntas (un mínimo de cinco y un máximo de ocho) referentes a la experiencia de vivir y trabajar en los Estados Unidos. **Tu entrevista debe durar un mínimo de 8-10 minutos, pero no más de 20 minutos.**
3. Concuerta un día y una hora para entrevistar a la persona. Recuerda enfatizar que este trabajo es para una clase y que solamente tú y tu instructor/a verán la entrevista. Tampoco se pedirá información personal.
4. Graba un vídeo de la entrevista.
5. Comparte tu vídeo con tu instructor/a (en tu carpeta de Google) y escribe entre 100 y 150 palabras explicando por qué elegiste a la persona que entrevistaste y qué aprendiste de la experiencia de hablar con esta persona.
6. Entrega todo tu material antes de la fecha límite dada.
