

NOTES FROM PATENT:

Petition filed by Jacob P. Leese Feb. 5, 1853.

Amendatory Petition filed on Aug. 4, 1854.

Tract of land called "Sausal," containing two square leagues, more or less, Monterey County.

Claim founded in two Mexican grants: one made Aug. 2, 1834 by José Figuerra, Governor of California; the other by Governor Pio Pico on Aug. 10, 1845.

Board of Land Commissioners ordered decree of confirmation on Aug. 15, 1854; confirmed by District Court SD of California at the December term 1856

P. 2 – known by the name of "Sauzal" and was formerly occupied by Tiburcio Castro

-- described lands surrounding Sauzal

-- said grant of the same made by Governor Pio Pico to José Castro and his sister Francisco on the Aug 10, 1845, which is on file in the case.

P. 3 – initial survey Oct. 1858.
