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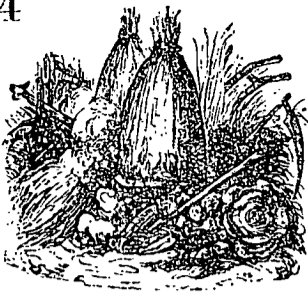
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The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved July 2, 1862, entitled "An Act Donating Public Lands to the several States and Territories which may provide Colleges for the benefit of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts," there has been deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** Scrip No. 527, for one quarter section of Land, in favor of the State of ^{Calif.} *Tennessee*, duly assigned by the proper authority of the said State to *Robert Watt*

with evidence that the same has been located upon *the North West quarter of section eight in Township twenty seven, South, of Range thirteen, East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Van Francisco, California, containing one hundred and sixty acres (the said tract being East of the San Bernardino Meridian)* according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the *Surveyor General*:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the **UNITED STATES** unto the said *Robert Watt*, as Assignee, as aforesaid, and this heurs *the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Robert Watt, as Assignee, as aforesaid, and this heirs and assigns forever.*

In Testimony Whereof, *J. Myrnes Grant*, President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the **SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be herunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the *first* day of *May*, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *fifty nine*, and of the Independence of the United States the *thirty third*

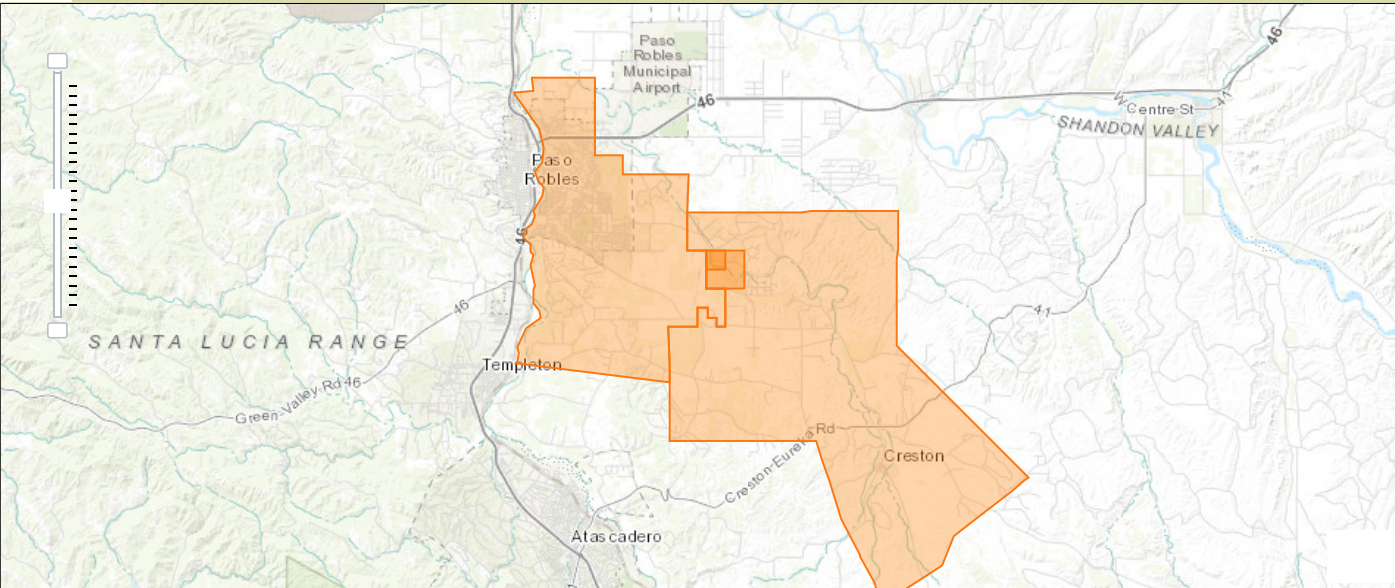
